

Southern Scholarship Foundation Hawksley Presidential Scholarship

The George Hawksley Endowment Fund was created by George W. Hawksley in order that his generosity in life could support Southern Scholarship Foundation in perpetuity. Upon his death in 1996, his bequest helped build two scholarship houses at the University of Florida as well as establish an endowment. The endowment was created with two purposes; to provide low interest loans and/or scholarships for students living in a Foundation scholarship house and to provide an expansion fund that would allow Southern Scholarship Foundation to further its mission. SSF is proud to honor Mr. Hawksley's wishes by providing the **Hawksley Presidential Scholarship**.

This scholarship opportunity is offered to eligible SSF residents entering either their senior year of college or final year of graduate/medical/law school. One recipient will be chosen from both the North Florida and Central Florida campuses. The scholarship will be presented in August at the SSF Kick-Off.

FINANCIAL AWARD

The recipient will have his/her SSF Food & Services Bill paid for the fall and spring semesters immediately following award of the scholarship.

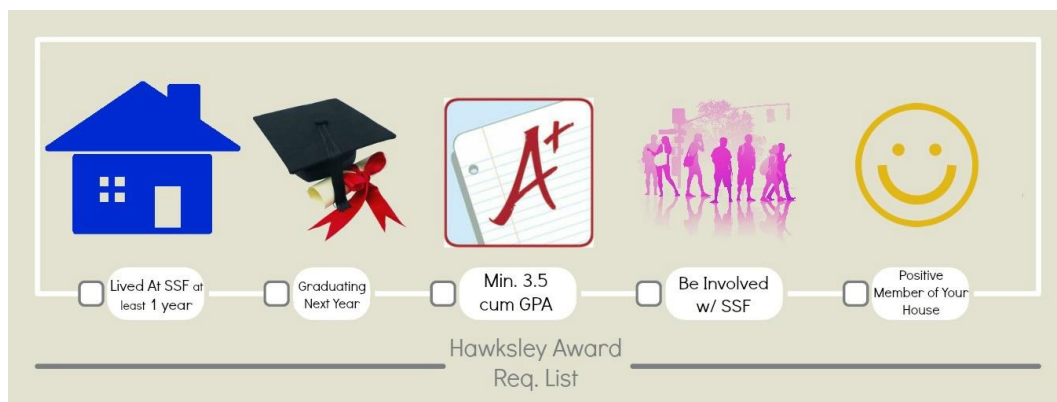
ELIGIBILITY

- Applicants must be current SSF residents entering either their senior year of college or final year of graduate/medical/law school. NOTE: If you are granted the scholarship for your senior year of undergrad and are accepted into your graduate program, you understand that you cannot re-apply.
- Applicants must have lived at SSF for the fall and spring semesters immediately preceding their senior year or final year of graduate/medical/law school.
- Applicants must have a minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA at the time of application.
- Applicants must be actively involved in SSF as well as the community.
- You may be awarded this scholarship whether you are graduating in the upcoming fall or spring semester.
- If for whatever reason an applicant is awarded this scholarship and their graduation is postponed they would no longer be eligible and would refund any monies paid on their behalf for that semester.

If the scholarship recipient's GPA falls below a cumulative 3.0, the scholarship will be revoked.

Applicants must submit the attached application and a 3 to 5 minute (creative & engaging) video illustrating their merit for the scholarship.
